

## Steps to becoming an Outreach Trainer for the Maritime Industry with the Mid Atlantic OSHA Training Institute Education Center (MAOTIEC).

1. Must have 5 years of Occupational Safety & Health have five (5) years maritime industry safety experience. Your experience must be related to safety activities demonstrating knowledge and use of OSHA standards.

Note: Working safely does not meet the requirements of safety experience needed for an OSHA trainer course

Note: If you have one of the following, you may substitute 2 years of experience: A degree in occupational safety and health from an accredited college or university, certification a Certified Safety Professional (CSP), a Certified Industrial Hygienist (CIH), or a Certified Marine Chemist (CMC) may be substituted for two (2) years of work-related experience.

2. Successful completion of the OSHA 5410 – Standards for the Maritime Industry (Prerequisite course) within the last 7 years.
3. Complete the Prerequisite Verification Form (PVF) for the Mid Atlantic OTI Education Center and send to [info@oshamidatlantic.org](mailto:info@oshamidatlantic.org) for review and approval.

Note: You must complete the entire Prerequisite Verification Form (PVF) to be considered in the Outreach program. Please do not send resume.

Note: Send a copy of your OSHA 5410 certificate, completed in the last 7 years with you PVF

4. Once your PVF is approved, register, and complete the OSHA 5400 Trainer Course In Occupational Safety And Health Standards For The Maritime Industry.
