What does VILT stand for?

VILT stands for Virtual Instructor-Led Training

Do I need a camera to take a VILT course?

Yes, your camera has to be turned on throughout the duration of the course

What platform is used to conduct a VILT course?

We use WebEx and Blackboard to conduct online trainings. A lockdown browser is used during testing for some courses

How do I receive my course materials?

You will receive a confirmation email from one of our staff members. In that confirmation email they will ask for your mailing address. You must confirm to receive your materials

What do I need to successfully complete a VILT course?

Each student will need a computer, camera, microphone & course materials. You will also need to show your photo ID on the first day

Is there a test?

Some courses require a test on the last day

Are VILT courses the same price as in person courses?

Yes, VILT and in-person courses are the same price

How do I receive a link to join the course?

You will receive an email from the facilitator 3 days before the course. That email will have specific directions for how to log in and a direct link to the classroom

How do I receive my card or certificate?

You will receive a digital copy of your certificate a week after the course. Courses that require a card, will be sent to your mailing address that you confirmed during the course

What does the facilitator do?

The facilitator helps the instructor and students throughout the course. If there are any technical issues the facilitator is there for assistance
